B. RAY'S RACING REPORT - Week Ending 13th July

In fairly good conditions of a force 4 Westerly breeze, but decreasing as the night dragged on, ten dinghies set off for an evening race at the Brading Haven Yacht Club last Saturday.

Under the control of race officer Lizzie Mitchell, a course was set west of St Helens Fort and with the two Contender boys leading the fast handicap fleet at the start, the chase was on.

Roger and Gill Herbert sailed a blinder in their Wayfarer, keeping up in the top three for the whole race and although narrowly missing a second position across the finish line, made a top notch first place on handicap by 116 seconds. This left the second spot to Martyn Davies with Richard Coleman in third, both sailing Contenders.

There were plenty of spills and thrills amongst the slow handicap class, which consisted of all Scows, trying to get round the course before the wind dropped. After less than an hour's racing, Mike Toogood pulled off a fine win of 72 seconds from Graham Sutton in second place and Michael Quinn third.
