Conditions of application

All applicants **must** feel confident in the water.

Courses STW 2012

(Ages are a guideline only)

Course 1 Young Sailors 8 – 10 years (£165)

A course to introduce young sailors to water borne activities. No previous experience necessary. Fun and games both off the water and on/in it!

Course 2 Young Sailors Improvers 9 – 11 (£165)

An improvers course for those who want to gain or have got SS1 or SS2. This course is to improve boat handling skills and awareness of our sailing environment.

Course 3 RYA Youth Stage 3 11 + (£195)

A suitable course for those aged 11 and above who have done little or no sailing leading to RYA Youth Stage 3.

Course 4 RYA Youth Stage 4 11+ (£195)

A course for children with some experience (equivalent to RYA Level 1) to improve their skills to RYA Youth Stage 4.

Course 5 Hot Shots 13+ (£195)

This course is for children who have got RYA Stage 4 or RYA Level 2 or equivalent to improve their abilities and introduce them to more advanced skills such as seamanship, racing, day sailing, spinnaker/asymmetric sailing.

ADULT COURSES

Course A Adult Beginners 16+ (£210)

This course is for adults (16+) who want to learn to sail with like-minded beginners away from young eyes and their helpful comments. An introduction to sailing leading to RYA Level 2.

Course B Adult Improvers 16 + (£210)

Adult improvers course for those who can sail and want to improve their skills and learn new ones. Racing, Day Sailing, Spinnakers. Your course your choice!

Course C RYA Powerboat Level 2 (£210)

A week in a practical environment to hone your skills up to RYA PB Level 2. More time on the water than a normal course to gain experience of 'on the water' situations.
